Welcome 2012!

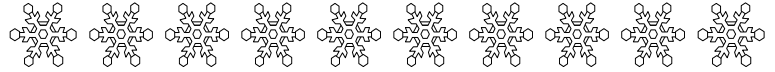
I wish you all a happy and healthy

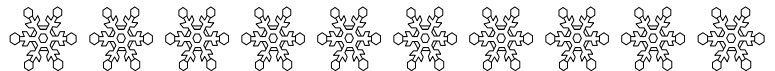

Class Make-up Policy
